

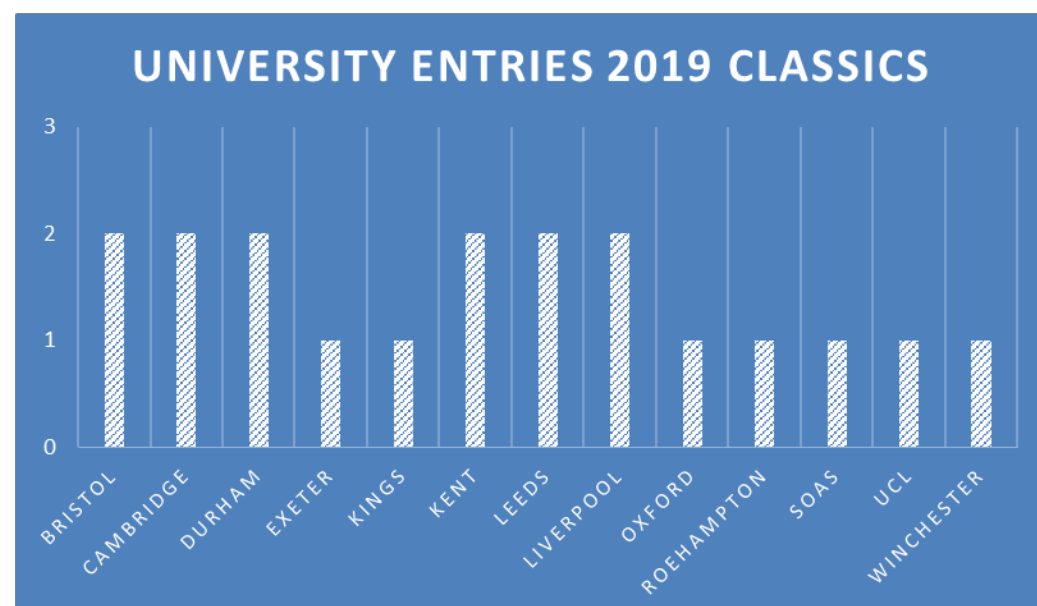
Classical Civilisation

Higher Education at BHASVIC 2019

In Sept 2019, 19 BHASVIC students went onto study Classics-related degrees at 9 different universities

This included 3 students going onto study Archaeology.

It is popular combined with other subjects including English, History and History of Art. 33% of our A2 Classics students went on to study the subject at degree level.



Should I study Classics at degree level?

As a humanities subject, there are about 10 hours of contact time per week, with a mix of lectures and seminars. The content varies over the optional modules, but is usually challenging and engaging.

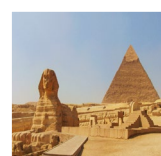
Average 10 contact hours a week:

- Classical civilisation

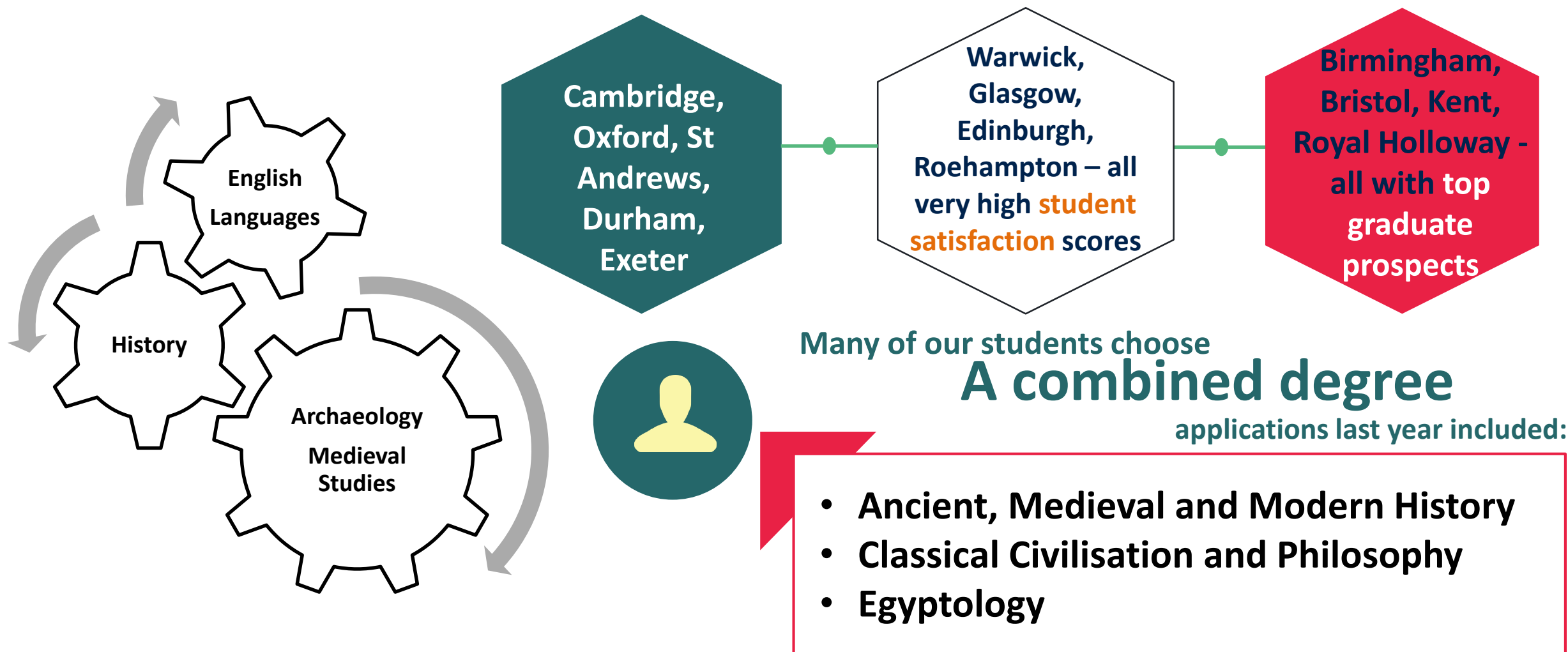
