

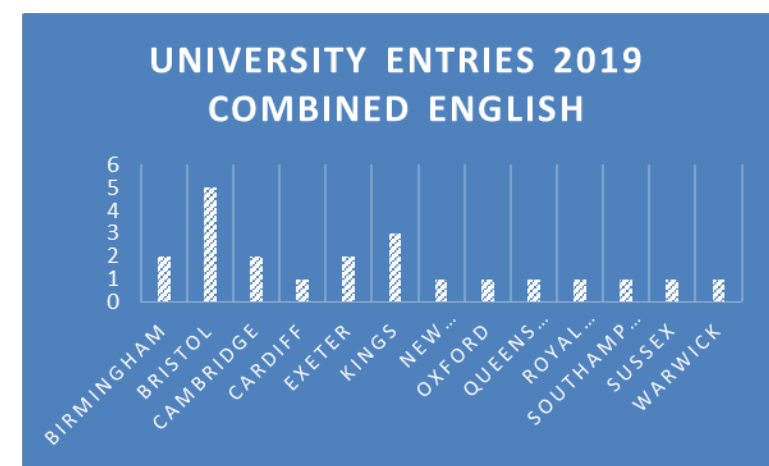
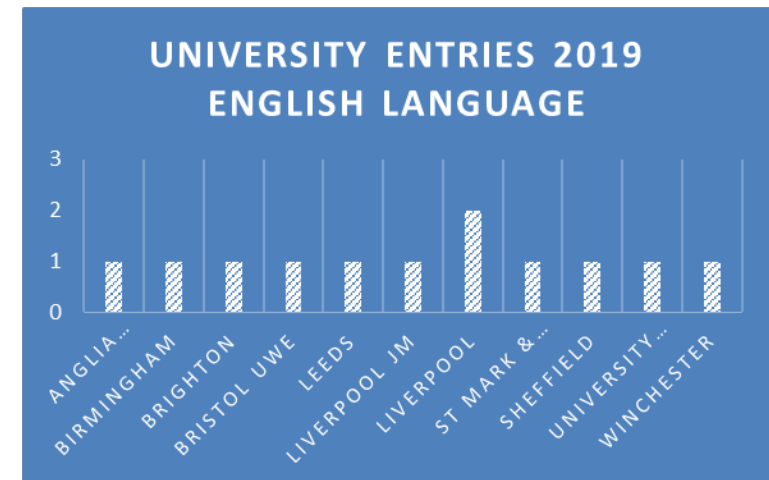
# English Language

## Higher Education at BHASVIC 2019

**In Sept 2019, 12 BHASVIC students studied English Language at 11 different universities. 22 students studied combined English at 13 different unis**

English remains year on year **top ten** subjects for University study.

Students study English Language, English Literature or a combination of both at A level.



## Should I study English Language at degree level?

Are you interested in how children acquire language, how English is structured and how it can be used for communication, such as in creative writing or advertising?

Due to the nature of the course with a lot of private study and reading/writing time, English students tend to be in classrooms and lecture halls a total of 8 hours a week.



### Types of degree

- You can choose to study straight English Language or combine to an English degree
- You can specialise in creative writing and linguistics
- Closely allied are a range of journalism, media and screenwriting degrees



### Entry Requirements

- A-levels (or equivalent) usually required
- English literature / language
- Useful to have
  - History
  - Religious studies
  - French or another foreign language
  - Latin or another classical language

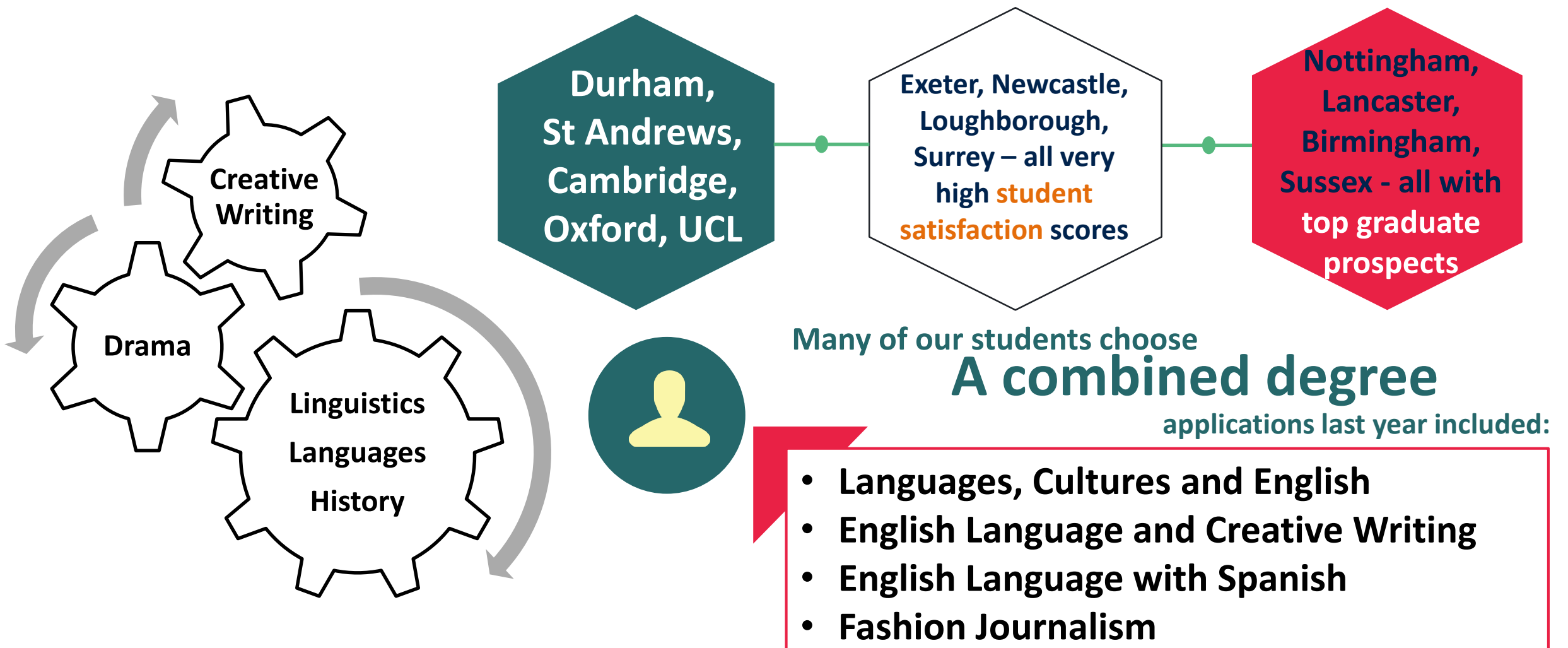
