From Sept 2017 to June 2018 we processed 1024 UCAS applications

59% of leavers entered higher education with almost 20% more taking a gap year.

Including 183 Oxbridge/Medics

Including 228 ex-students

Up from 893 in 2015

97.7% of BHASVIC students applying to University successfully began a university course, compared with a national figure of 74.5% for post-16 education.

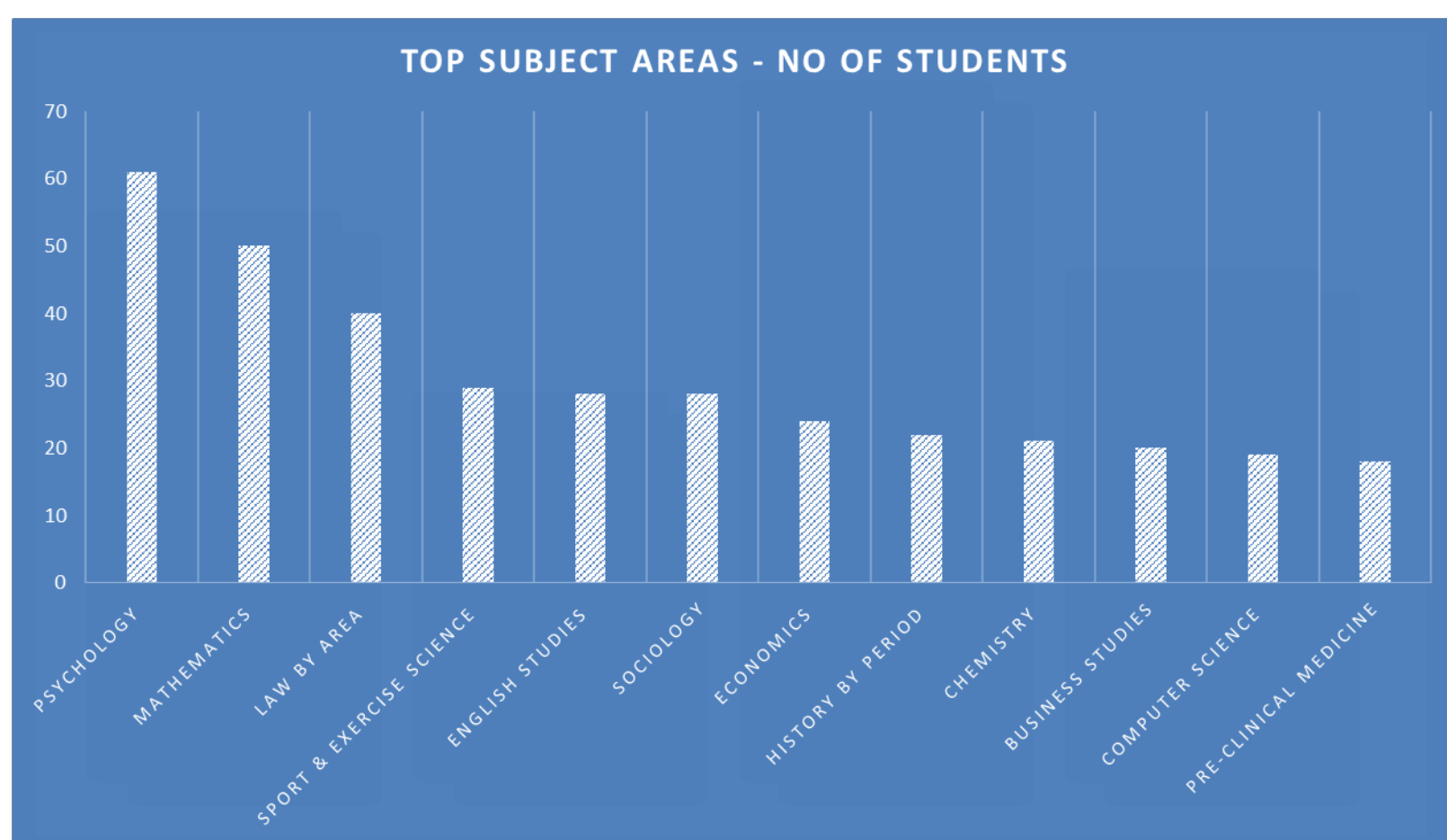

93% of our students achieve first and 2:1 degrees, substantially higher than the independent, state and sixth form sector in general. For students from low participation wards for all UK universities the figure is 92% compared to 69% for state schools
