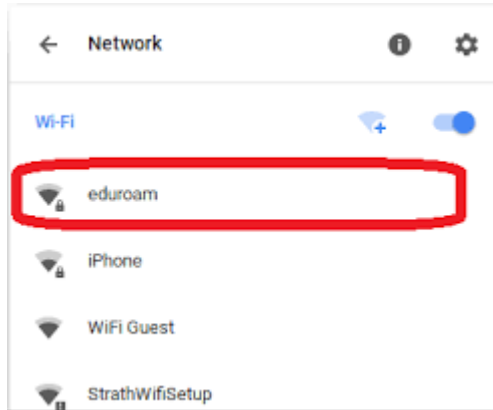
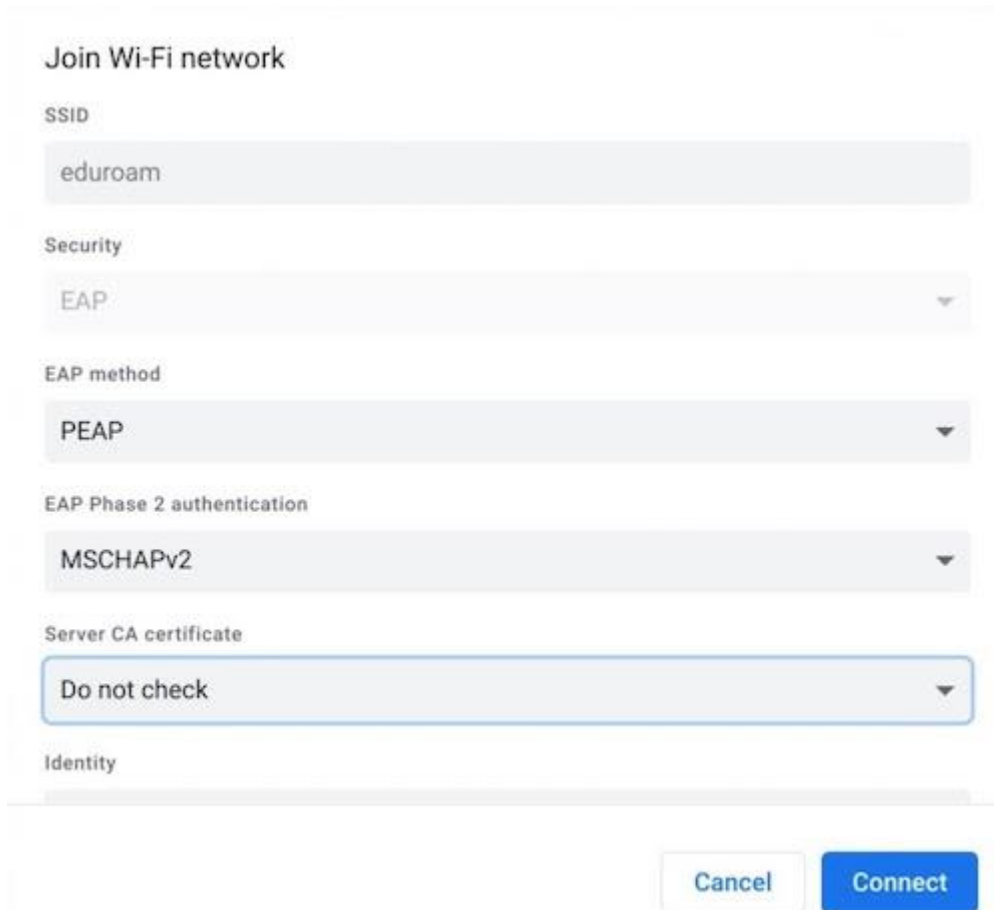


Connecting a Chromebook to eduroam

1. Select eduroam from list of available Wi-fi connections:



2. Make sure the following settings are set to these options:

Anonymous Identity: *Leave blank*

Password: *Your BHASVIC password*
