Denmark Residential Trip

Year 1 Geography A Level

Skills Weeks – early July 2025

Dear Parents/ Carers,

With the threat of climate change an underpinning theme in the Geography A Level, the department wishes to offer residential trips which are both relevant and exciting without resorting to private transport and air travel. For the last 2 years we have run a 6-day trip to the west coast of Denmark where we will travel by train, bus, bike and foot to foster self-sufficiency in our students and help them explore themes relevant to our A Level. By choosing to travel to Denmark by train rather than flying we will save over 9 tonnes of carbon dioxide which would fill up 45 double decker buses or be equivalent to the carbon emissions generated when producing 1,242 meat-based meals!

We have yet to decide on the itinerary for 2025 but we expect the cost to be approx. £980. This is 2024 itinerary....

- InterRail pass for travel London to Denmark plus all seat reservations
- 2 nights in Hamburg, Germany
- 4 nights in Esbjerg, Denmark
- All meals
- Bike hire whilst in Denmark
- Visit to Wadden Sea National Park with talk/ fieldwork
- Visit to Ribe
- Visit Ribe Vikinger and Cathedral Tower
- Day at Fano Island with beach clean
- Energy efficiency talk at University of Southern Denmark
- Selection of activities/ visits in Hamburg
- Travel Insurance

If your young person is interested in joining this trip, you do not need to do anything at this stage. We will contact students/ parents & carers in the Autumn term with all the finalised details, but we are aware that finances are a concern for many at the moment, so we just wanted to let you know about this opportunity as far in advance as possible, so you have time to financially plan if you wish.

All payments for trips are through our BHASVIC Parent Pay account, you will be sent details on how to activate your account once your young person has enrolled, we do encourage you to set your account up as soon as possible on receipt of these details to avoid any delays later.
