Dear Parents/ Carers,

Running alongside the curriculum BHASVIC aims to provide enriching trips linked to students' studies that not only bring their studies to life but also encourage independence & an opportunity to make new friends & have new experiences.

As part of Biology/ Environmental Studies courses we hoping to run a 3-day residential trip to Nettlecombe Court in early July 2025 during Skills Week. Nettlecombe Court is a Tudor mansion located on the edge of Exmoor National Park, it is run by the Field Studies Council, an environmental education charity. Over the 3-days students will be able to immerse themselves in field work relevant to their studies.

We have yet to decide the itinerary for the 2025 trip, but we expect the cost for this trip to be around £480.

If your young person is interested in joining this trip, you do not need to do anything at this stage. We will contact students/ parents & carers in the Autumn term with all the finalised details, but we are aware that finances are a concern for many at the moment, so we just wanted to let you know about this opportunity as far in advance as possible, so you have time to financially plan if you wish.

All payments for trips are through our BHASVIC Parent Pay account, you will be sent details on how to activate your account once your young person has enrolled, we do encourage you to set your account up as soon as possible on receipt of these details to avoid any delays later.
