Running alongside the curriculum BHASVIC aims to provide enriching trips linked to students' studies that not only bring their studies to life but also encourage independence & an opportunity to make new friends & have new experiences.

As part of the Early Modern History A Level course, we hoping to run a 4-day residential trip to Rouen, France in April 2025. We have yet to have detailed itinerary but below is a rough idea of what the trip will cover, expecting the cost to be around £200.

Return ferry from Newhaven to Dieppe
All train travel whilst in France
3-night Bed & Breakfast accommodation
Guided tour Rouen Cathedral
Admission to the Joan of Arc Museum
Admission Gros Clock
Admission to the Bayeaux Museum/ Bayeaux Tapestry

If your young person is interested in joining this trip, you do not need to do anything at this stage. We will contact students/ parents & carers in the Autumn term with all the finalised details, but we are aware that finances are a concern for many at the moment, so we just wanted to let you know about this opportunity as far in advance as possible, so you have time to financially plan if you wish.

All payments for trips are through our BHASVIC Parent Pay account, you will be sent details on how to activate your account once your young person has enrolled, we do encourage you to set your account up as soon as possible on receipt of these details to avoid any delays later.
